The book of Melachim (11 14:26-27) states: For the Lord saw that Israel's affliction was very bitter. And there was none surviving and none remaining and there was no helper for Israel. But the Lord did not speak to erase the name of Israel from under the heavens, so He saved them by the hand of Yerovam ben Yoash. The Midrash Tanchuma comments:

But the Lord did not speak... Why is Yerovam mentioned here? Was he not an idolater? The explanation is that [he deserved this] because he did not listen to gossip about Amos. At that time, the generation and its leader worshipped idols. Nevertheless, [God said], "The Land which I promised to give to the descendants of Avraham, Yitzchak, and Ya'akov, give it over into the hands of he who did not listen to gossip." They say: that which was not given over into the hands of Yehoshua bin Nun and David, king of Israel, was given over into Yerovam's hands, as it says, So He saved them by the hand of Yerovam ben Yoash

Thus, when the Almighty wants to save Israel from exceedingly dire circumstances, He saves them even by way of the most wicked person, like an idolater...[With some uncommon quality]
