We appreciate receiving your letter dated August 17, 1967, regarding various Parke-Davis products. We are pleased to supply the information requested.

- Benadryl Kapseals, 50 mg. contain a small quantity of corn starch. The 25 mg. capsules do not contain any grain products. Elixir Benadryl contains alcohol.
- 2. Benylin Expectorant contains glucose and alcohol. As you know, we supply Benadryl powder which would enable you to compound prescriptions with alternate diluents.
- 3. Kapseals Carbrital and Carbrital Half-Strength do not contain any grain products. The elixir contains alcohol.
- 4. Kapseals Chloromycetin and Chloromycetin Palmitate do not contain any grain derivatives.
- 5. Dilantin Kapseals and infatabs contain corn starch.
 S. G. Capsules Dilantin do not contain grain products.
 Dilantin Suspension contains alcohol. We also supply Dilantin in powder form for prescription compounding.

- 6. Norlestrin 1 mg. and 2.5 mg. tablets contain corn starch.
- 7. Povan Suspension does not contain any grain derivatives.
 Povan Tablets contain corn starch.
